Course Title	Course Description	Grade s
Video Game Design and Creation I – Senior Maze (GM1)	Design, build and take-home your own Windows-based video games. Learn to create your own game storyline, draw or import characters and backgrounds and apply sound effects if computers allow. Learn fundamentals of programming and video game design. Emphasizing a creative and inventive process with a no-violence policy, it effectively moves children from passive players of video games, to becoming active participants in the design and creation of their own games.	For grades 2-8
Video Game Design and Creation II – Master Platforms (GM2)	This class is for both new and returning students. Design, build and take-home your own Platform Games with advanced techniques such as Gravity, Tiling, Platform Building, Jumping, Path, Moving Enemies, Moving Background and Views, Secret Tunnel, Shooting, etc. Adventure with your characters through the mythical world where jumping is a must to get around. Collect treasures and avoid all dangers to finally reach your destination to win the game. Learn fundamentals of programming and video game design. Develop creative and inventive skills with popular media. No more passive playing of video games.	For grades 3-8
Computer Keyboarding / Typing (KT1)	Keyboarding or Typing skills have become essential in today's computer age. This course will teach the right fingering before kids get into the hunt-and-peck habit. Do it the right way at the beginning! Exercises are gauged to take the beginning typist from hunt-and-peck to gradually build typing skills with speed, accuracy and control.	For grades 3-8.
Flash Animated Picture Creation Workshop (FA1)	Create Animation for your website, presentation, and even your own movies! Bring to life your creative ideas by making animated pictures; learn the techniques to develop movie clips, multi-scene movies, and experiment with the power and effects of lighting, sound and music. Hands-on exercises to learn to create computer animations like a pro!	For grades 3-8.
Website Design and Publishing (WD1)	Kids learn how to make their own web page and publish it on the World Wide Web. Topics covered: Web Design with WYSIWYG (what you see is what you get) tools; HTML concepts; Primary tags; Hyperlinks; text formatting; Colors, backgrounds and fonts; Pictures, graphics and animations; Tables; Web publishing; and more!	For grades 4-8

Each of these classes could be run as a week-long summer camp, two hours a day Monday through Friday. I suggest to schedule two camps for each class during the summer. Tuition is \$199 per student.
